DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT - This project, situated in the Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center (JHBMC) in Baltimore, MD, consists of an expansion and renovation of the Emergency Department. Work shall be conducted in six phases as summarized below.

Phase 1 - Demolition of the existing emergency department entry vestibule and associated canopy as well as demolition of the existing basement level.

Phase 2 - Construction of emergency department additions including MEP rooms on the Basement level; ambulance entry, trauma area, walk-in entry, family lounge, patient in-take and fast track areas on the first floor; adult observation areas on the second floor; and pediatric observation and pediatric

Phase 3 - Interior demolition of a portion of the existing Emergency Department, construction of the Psychiatric Evaluation Services Suite, renovation of the staff services as well as work within the existing basement.

Phase 4 - Demolish a portion of the existing Emergency Department, construction of general exam rooms and critical care bays, as well as work within the existing basement.

Phase 5 - Includes renovation and construction within the existing connecting corridor between the Emergency Department and the FSK pavilion.

Phase 6 - Demolish existing Emergency Department fast-track trailer as well as patching and repairing the exterior façade of the FSK Pavilion to match adjacent.

INFORMATION REGARDING COMPANY'S BONDING REQUIREMENTS

PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING BONDS

Subcontractors who do not already have a surety company relationship should be prepared to furnish the following minimum information to a surety agency so the agency can successfully place the required bonds with a surety company.

- 1. Last 3-5 years of the company's financial statement.
- 2. Current personal financial statements of the stockholders.
- 3. List of major projects completed in the last 3-5 years including the Owner's or prime contractor's name, address, telephone number, the final contract price and final profit.
- 4. Schedule listing current incomplete work including the contract price, projected profit, billing to date and cost to date of each project.
- 5. Resume of Key personnel.
- 6. Letter from the company's bank indicating the nature of the relationship and the line of credit if one is being provided.
- 7. List of major suppliers including name, address, telephone number, the terms and limits of credit extended.
- 8. A detailed account of its continuity arrangements including buy-out provision, if any.
