Accepted Bidders will be required, as a condition precedent to award of Contract, to furnish in the amount of 100% of the contract price, satisfactory Performance Bond and Payment Bond and Certificates of Insurance as required in the Project Manual. Barton Malow Builders reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to replace Performance Bond and Payment Bond coverage with enrolment in its subcontractor default program.
4. Unless otherwise specifically set forth in Section 000880 of the Project Manual, this Project is subject to state sales and/or use taxes and Bidder is required to include such taxes in its Bid Proposal.
5. Barton Malow Builders has been contracted by the Owner in the capacity of Construction Manager for the Project, and as such has the rights and obligations set forth in its contract with the Owner for those services, and shall act as Owner's construction manager to the extent required/allowed under its Owner contract.
6. Bid Proposals will be opened by Barton Malow Builders, evaluated by Barton Malow Builders, the Owner, and the Architect, with recommended awards subsequently made by Barton Malow Builders.

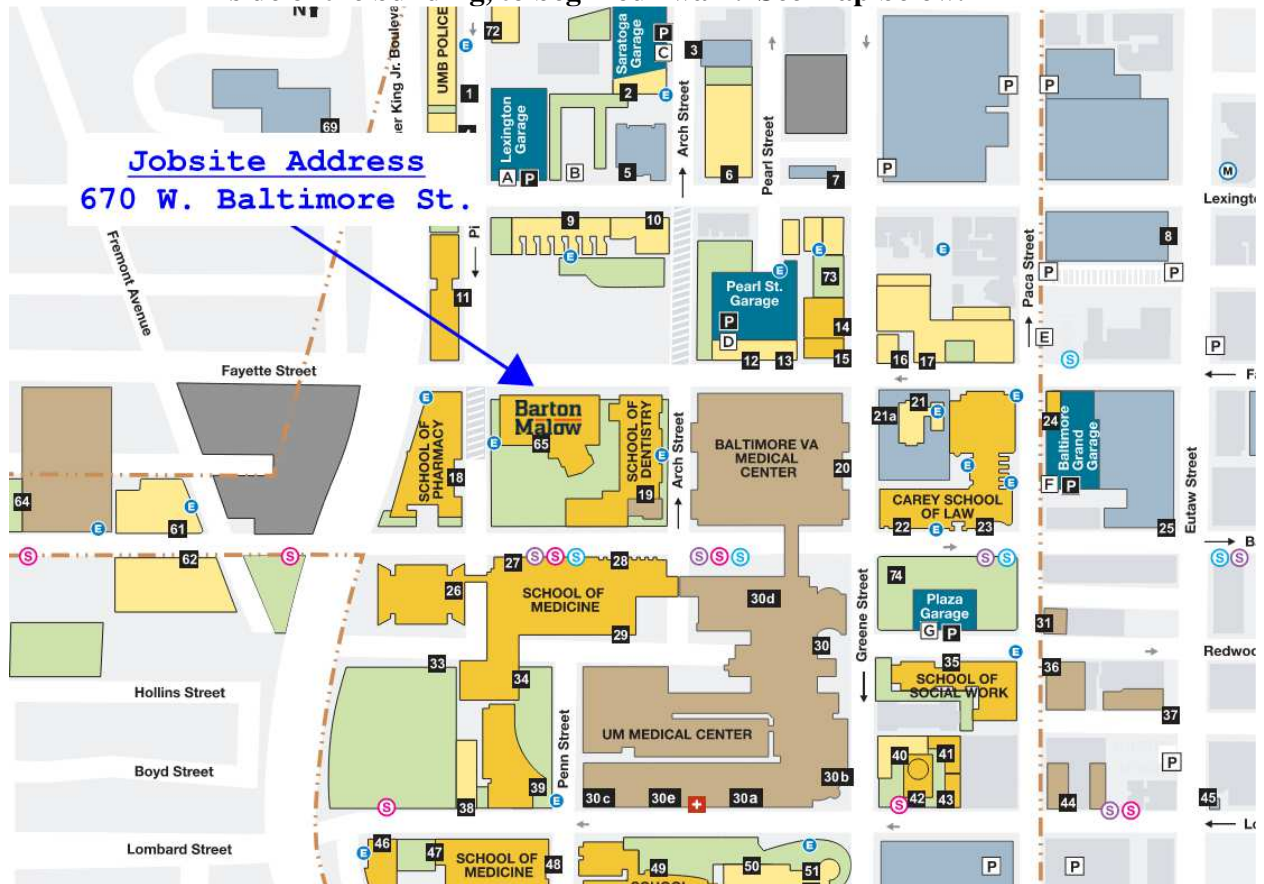

Information disclosed in the pre-bid conference minutes will be considered part of the Bidding and Contract Documents.

10. Questions from bidders shall be due to Barton Malow Builders by 2:00 PM, Friday, June 28th, 2024. Expect responses to be issued via Addenda, with the final addenda being issued no later than Friday, July 5th, 2024. Forward all questions to maxwell.jenney@bartonmalow.com.
11. Bidders must **be in the pre-qualification process for this bid package by Barton Malow Builders** before document distribution or receipt of bids per the Instructions to Bidders. Barton Malow Builders reserves the right to request qualification forms or additional information from any Bidder before issuing Bidding Documents, receiving Bid Proposals or awarding the Agreement. Barton Malow Builders may elect to waive these requirements on a case-by-case basis at its sole discretion.
12. Bidders will be required to submit with their Bid Proposals a Bid Security by a qualified surety authorized to do business in the state where the Project is located, an OSHA Form 300 for the most recent completed year, their worker's compensation Experience Modification Rate (EMR) factor, and any other information required in the Instructions to Bidders. Bidders shall not withdraw Bid Proposals for a period of one hundred and fifty (150) days after date for receipt of Bid Proposals.
13. The successful Bidder(s) will be required to enter into an agreement with Barton Malow Builders on the Agreement Form identified in Section 000500 of the Project Manual.
14. The right to reject any or all Bid Proposals, either in whole or in part or to waive any informalities or irregularities therein is reserved by the Owner and/or Barton Malow Builders.
15. The project shall be priced with standard insurance. Ref. section 0000610 for specific requirements.
